

Agent Day & Other Audition Dress Code

Keep in mind that anytime you come to the Agency, please look presentable, as if you are going to an audition. Talent who DO NOT look appropriate are not taken seriously in this industry.

❖ Dress Code tips:



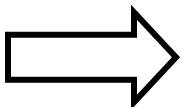
- Wear a **solid bright** (not Neon) color top:
 - Blues (Best color)
 - Pinks
 - Yellows
 - Oranges
- Most auditions are “On Camera” **do not wear** Red, Black, White, Stripes, Plaids, or a **Busy** looking top.
- The Agent must see your eyes, **pull** or **pin** back your hair so your hair doesn’t fall in your eyes during your audition.

Additional tips:



- No Jeans that have holes or rips
- No belly showing outfits
- No flip flops
- No see through clothing
- No short skirts
- No big jewelry
- No chipped finger nail polish
- No Tennis Shoes

If you are asked to “dress casual” for an audition:
casual is **NOT** wearing T-shirts, Jeans, or Tennis Shoes.
