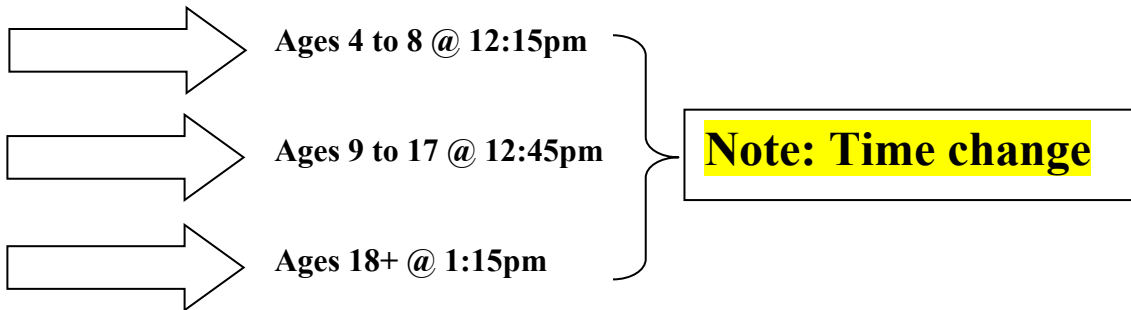

If you are the age of 9 and over, you will be getting the commercial script when you arrive at the Agency. This is called a “Cold Script”. If you are of the ages 8 and under, your script is below to memorize. You will have time to go over the commercial prior to seeing the Industry Professional along with your Local Representative.

Bring the commercial to “Life”. We are **not** interested in your reading skills...we are interested in your “Acting Skills”.

We will be looking to see **how**:

- **animated** you are
- **creative** you are
- **what choices you make in the delivery of the cold script commercial**

Staple your resume to the 4 corners of your headshot. Make sure the resume is facing out.
