Double Bubble

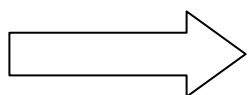
I love Double Bubble gum, I can blow big bubbles, with a lot of training of course.

Ages 7-8

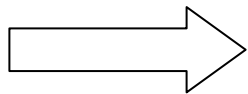
Double Bubble

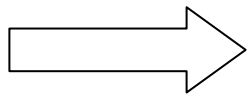
